### **Introduction:**

2. In our text, Israel was camped overlooking the Promised Land.
3. They were about to cross over into the new beginnings where God wanted them.
4. Moses gave some Scriptural challenges to Israel and us.
5. As we have crossed into the new year, we need to be reminded of:

### **I. (v. 11) GOD'S PROVISION.**

1. God has met our needs.
2. God continues to meet our needs as we pray to Him.
3. Philippians 4:19 – ***But my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.***

### **II. (v. 12) GOD'S PRESENCE.**

1. The eyes of the Lord are always on us.
2. Zechariah 4:10 – ***The eyes of the Lord run to and fro through the whole earth.***
3. Hebrews 13:5 – ***I will never leave you nor forsake you.***

### **III. (vv. 13-15) GOD'S PROMISE.**

1. (v. 13) God's promise is conditional.
2. (vv. 14-15) God's promise is continual.

### **IV. (vv. 16-24) GOD'S PROTECTION.**

1. (v. 16) Protect our hearts from deceit.
2. (v. 17) Protected hearts ward off disaster.
3. (vv. 18-22) Protect the heart of our ancestors.
4. (vv. 23-24) Protection from the Lord will be our deliverance.

As we crossed over into new dimensions this year, we must cross with the Lord and His guidance.
