SEVEN STEPS FROM DEATH TO LIFE

Luke 17:11-19

Introduction:

- 1. The blessings of God reveals the condition of the heart.
- 2. God's blessings reveal either self-centeredness or God-centeredness.
- (v. 12) THEY ALL HAD THE SAME DISEASE (Leprosy equals sin).
 - 1. Psalm 51:5 says, "Behold, I was shaped in iniquity and in sin did my mother conceive me."
 - 2. Rom 5:12 says, "Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world and death by sin and so death passed upon all men for all have sinned."
- II. (v. 12) THEY WERE ALL IN THE SAME PLACE (A far off distanced them).
 - 1. Ephesians 2:17 says, "And came and preached peace to you who were afar off, and to them that were near."
 - 2. They were in a leper colony, the Samaritan and all the Jews.
 - 3. They were to wear a mask and yell "Unclean" to all approaching.
- III. (v. 13) THEY ALL CRIED TO THE SAME PERSON (To Jesus for healing).
 - 1. We all want God's mercy and healing, but what about a heart healing?
 - 2. Matthew 9:27 says, "And when Jesus departed from there, two blind men followed Him, crying, and saying, Thou Son of David, have mercy on us."
- IV. (v. 13) THEY ALL CRIED FOR THE SAME THING (Mercy--helplessness).
 - 1. When you stand before God, do you want mercy or justice?
 - 2. What do you want for your neighbors or enemies in life?
- V. (v. 14) THEY ALL GOT THE SAME PRESCRIPTION (Go in obedience).
 - 1. God's prescription for healing spiritually is always the same.
 - 2. John 5:14 says, "And afterward Jesus finds him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, you are made well; sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto you."

[They all had the same disease, were in the same place, called the same person, begged for the same thing, and they were given the same prescription, now]

- VI. (v. 14) THEY ALL GOT THE SAME BLESSING (Cleansing from disease).
 - 1. They were healed at the hand of Jesus.
 - 2. All escaped impending physical death and society's segregation.

VII. (vv. 15-19) ONLY ONE GOT REGENERATION (Saved from sin).

- 1. Hebrews 11:6 says, "But without faith it is impossible to please Him; for he that comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him."
- 2. (v. 15) The healed leper glorified God for his physical healing.
- 3. (v. 16) The cleansed leper glorified God in his humility.
- 4. (vv. 17-18) The other 9 ungrateful lepers grieved Jesus' heart.
- 5. (v. 19) The Samaritan leper only received spiritual healing as well.
- 6. (v. 19) All 10 lepers got their hides healed, but only one received heart healing.

Conclusion:

- 1. Everyone wants their hides healed, but few want their hearts healed.
- 2. We invest time, talents, and money on those things and people we love.
- 3. Where is God on our list?
- 4. If Jesus blessed your life today, how would your heart respond?
- 5. I think we see right here how the average person responds to the blessings of God with only 10% are really changed in this miracle.
- 6. Is our average going to be greater than that of the Lord's ministry? (Something to ponder)
