Philippians 4:8-23

Introduction:

There are very few real Christian thinkers in the world today. The ability to think is a wonderful gift from God. The mind can lead us to find life or to lose our life and souls by pushing Christ out of our minds.

- I. (v. 8-9) A CHRISTIAN MINDSET INVOLVES CONCENTRATION UPON WHOLESOME THINGS. (Children's song: Input/Output)
 - 1. The devil has placed his bid for our minds.
 - A. Anything he can do to occupy our minds to keep us from concentrating on God's word & will for our lives he will do it.
 - B. Col. 3:2 Set your affections on things above and not on things on the earth.
 - 2. Concentrate on truthful things A man false in his engagements will disgrace Christianity.
 - 3. Honest Dishonesty brings reproach upon Christians.
 - 4. Lovely This word has to do with lovely in attitude.
 - 5. Things of good report Concentrate on things of good report.
 - 6. (v. 9) The God of Peace will guide your life if you do as He does Paul said do as I do.
- II. (vv. 10-11) A CHRISTIAN MINDSET INVOLVES CONCENTRATION UPON THE NEEDS OF THOSE THAT SHARE THE GOSPEL.
 - 1. (vv. 10-11) Paul rejoices that the church once again is able to minister to his needs.
 - 2. They lacked opportunity to help earlier.
 - 3. (v. 11) Paul often had need but learned to be content.
 - A. He had learned to lean on Jesus.
 - B. Through it all he had learned to depend upon the Lord.
 - C. A contented mind is an invaluable blessing not wanting unneeded things that won't be used.
 - 4. (v. 12) He knew what it was to have plenty & little also.
 - A. Adversity keeps the mind right, where prosperity doesn't.
 - B. Paul experienced rapid changes in supplies in his life.
 - C. America hasn't been forced recently to depend on God.

- 5. (v. 13) Paul learned he could make it through Christ.
 - A. Songs 'Jesus in the morning, Jesus in the evening" and "I Have a God Who Watches over Me."
 - B. If you walk by sight and not faith, it should scare you to death.
 - C. Have a friend that sticks closer than a brother.
- 6. (vv. 14-18) They took part in helping him and entered his affliction.

III. (v. 19) A CHRISTIAN MINSDSET INVOLVES REWARDS TO CHURCHES.

- 1. Rewards come to faithful Christians.
- 2. Rewards come to faithful churches.
 - A. God is not going to underwrite religious clubs.
 - B. God will underwrite a practicing New Testament church that's carrying out the Great Commission (Matt. 28:19-20).

IV. (v. 20) A CHRISTIAN MINDSET INVOLVES GIVING GOD THE GLORY FOREVER.

- 1. James 1:17 For every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of Lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.
- 2. I Thessalonians 5:18 In everything give thanks for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

V. (vv. 21-23) A CHRISTIAN MINDSET INVOLVES CHRISTIAN COURTESY.

- 1. Be convinced you are going to be courteous.
- 2. Go to guests and make them welcome.
- 3. Hebrews 13:2 Do not be forgetful to entertain strangers for thereby some have entertained angles unawares.
