WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A GOOD SOLDIER CITIZEN OF THE NATION?

Proverbs 14:34; Ephesians 6:12-17

[Review: Not only should we recognize our Enlistment and Enablement]

I. RESTRAIN YOURSELF FROM ENTANGLEMENTS.

- 1. Not only is it important what a soldier does, but what he doesn't do is just as important.
- 2. A soldier can be destroyed by getting entangled with other things of the world just as easily as he can die on the battlefield.
- 3. Il Tim. 2:4 states, **No man that wars entangles himself with the affairs** of this life that he may please Him who has chosen him to be a soldier.
- 4. Matthew 6:24 states, No man can serve two masters.
- 5. James 1:8 says, A double-minded man is unstable in all his ways.
- 6. I Thessalonians 2:4 states, **But as we were allowed of God to be put in** trust with the gospel, even so we speak: not as pleasing men, but God, who tests our hearts.
 - A. There are many things that are good but are not the best.
 - B. The commander wants soldiers to do the best things not good things.
- 7. The word *ENTANGLED* means to entwine like braiding the hair.
 - A. Samson got entwined with the affairs of the world and lost his life.
 - B. Lot got entwined with Sodom and lost almost all his family.
 - C. The Bible says in Genesis 13:10 that Lot looked toward Sodom.
 - D. In Genesis 13:12, Lot pitched his tent toward Sodom.
 - E. In Genesis 14:12, Lot moved to Sodom.
 - F. Lot never intended to end up in Sodom, but he first looked, then leaned, and finally lived in Sodom.
- 8. We need to walk to please God, and when a soldier makes a decision, the biggest question is not whether it is safe or popular, but is it right?
- 9. The church should receive God's orders from heaven just as an army receives order form a military commander.

[Recognize your Enlistment, Enablement, Restrain yourself from Entanglements]

II. RECEIVE AND GIVE ENCOURAGEMENT.

- 1. We do not stand alone even though we feel like it.
- 2. We are not fighting for victory, but from victory.
- 3. Il Corinthians 2:14a states, Now thanks be unto God, who always causes us to triumph in Christ

- 4. Colossians 2:15 states, *And having spoiled principalities and powers, He made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it.*
- 5. I Corinthians 15:57 says, **But thanks be to God who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.**

[Not only recognize your enlistment, enablement, restrain yourself from entanglement, receive and give encouragement, now lastly:]

III. RESPECT THE EQUIPMENT (Ephesians 6:12-17).

- 1. Safety equipment is often annoying to wear, but it is issued to prevent severe injury and ultimately to save your life.
- 2. In Ephesians, we are instructed to wear the whole armor of God.
 - A. The armor enables a soldier to stand before the battle (v. 11).
 - B. Withstand during the battle (v. 13).
 - C. Stand after the victory (v. 14).
- 3. The armor is first defensive and secondarily offensive.
- 4. The armor is worn to protect areas of need in our lives and to reject the strategy of Satan in attacking that area.
- 5. The armor is as follows:
 - A. The Helmet of Salvation.
 - B. The Breastplate of Righteousness
 - C. The Girdle of Truth (The girdle is more than a belt. It binds things tightly together around one's waist.)
 - D. The Shoes of Peace (This assures the soldier's firm footing.)
 - E. The Shield of Faith
 - F. The Sword of the Spirit (This is the Word of God.)
 - 1) Material swords are dead and grow dull, but the spiritual sword becomes sharper the more that it is used.
 - 2) A material sword brings death to living people, but the Sword of the Spirit brings life to people who are dead in sin.
 - 3) Material swords cut the outer person, but God's sword pierces the inner person and exposes exactly what is there.
 - 4) Military training manuals may become outdated, but not the Word of God, for it is forever settled in heaven (Ps. 119:89).
- 6. All the armor must be put on in the spirit of humility and prayer.
- 7. When we dress out with God, victory is certain!!!
