THE CHURCH'S AND OUR PURPOSE IN A CONFUSED NATION

Matthew 28:18-20

Introduction:

- 1. We're living in uncertain times, but Jesus's purpose hasn't changed.
- 2. Many churches and members have lost their way.
- 3. Heb 13:8 *Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today, and forever.*
- 4. Strange doctrines have arisen, but Jesus hasn't changed.

I. (v. 19a) MAKE DISCIPLES.

- A. As we are going, teach and preach the message of salvation.
- B. I Corinthians 15:3-4 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures; and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according the Scriptures.

II. (v. 19b) MARK DISCIPLES.

- A. We are to baptize into the church those who are saved.
- B. Baptism identifies you as being serious about being saved.
- C. Baptism means family exclusion & death in some countries.

III. (v. 20a) MATURE DISCIPLES.

- A. We are to teach new converts the milk & meat of the Bible.
- B. I Peter 2:2 As newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the Word, that you may grow by it.
- C. I Corinthians 3:2 I have fed you with milk and not with solid food; for to this time you were not able to bear it, neither yet now are you able.
- D. Ephesians 4:11-12 And He gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; for the perfecting of the saints for the work of the ministry for the edifying of the body of Christ.

Conclusion:

- 1. (v. 20b) Here is the Master's promise.
- 2. We can't claim, nor experience, His power nor promise until we live and serve according to His prescription.
