I. (v. 9) LOVE DIRECTS OUR CHARACTER.

- 1. True love is without hypocrisy.
- 2. Love must be sincere and moral.
- 3. Love rejects sin and clings to the good.
- 4. Our love for righteousness is measured by hating sin.

II. (v. 10) LOVE DIRECTS OUR CONTACTS.

- 1. Christian, moral love prefers a brother above oneself.
- 2. Ephesians 4:32 We're to be kind, tender-hearted, and forgiving.
- 3. We're to have family-like affection for others.

III. (v. 11) LOVE DIRECTS OUR CONDUCT.

- 1. We are to be earnestly serving God and "on fire" for Him.
- 2. Fervent in spirit means water brought to a boil.

IV. (v. 12) LOVE DIRECTS OUR CONVICTIONS.

- 1. This verse is speaking of our convictions in three areas which include the following: Praise, Patience, and Prayer.
- 2. A Christian without convictions is a tool in Satan's hands.

V. (v. 13) LOVE DIRECTS OUR CONCERNS.

- 1. Love opens our eyes to the needs of Christians.
- 2. Love causes us to practice hospitality.
