- I. (v. 7a) I Will Look in the Proper Place.
 - 1. Micah said, I will look unto the Lord.
 - 2. The majority doesn't know where nor to whom to look in crisis.
 - 3. Many look to drugs, alcohol, lawyers, politicians, and friends.
 - 4. Ps. 56:3 What time I am afraid, I will trust in you.
 - 5. Ps. 121:1-3 I will lift up my eyes unto the hills. . . .
 - 6. I Pt. 5:7 Casting all your care upon Him, for He cares. . ..
- II. (v. 7b) I Will Wait on the Proper Person.
 - 1. Micah said, I will wait for the God of my salvation.
 - 2. God's timing is best never early or late.
 - 3. Ps. 37:7-9 Rest in the Lord and wait patiently for Him.
 - 4. Ps. 27:14 Wait on the Lord: Be of good courage
- III. (v. 7c) I Will Have Faith in God Hearing my Petition.
 - 1. God desires to hear our petitions.
 - 2. In order to move the heart and hand of God, there are some things we need to bring in line with His holiness.
 - A. God requires a repentant heart (Ps. 66:18; I Pt. 3:12).
 - B. God requires a submissive heart.
 - 1) Submissive to His will (I Jn 5:14).
 - 2) Submissive to praying in Jesus's name (Jn 14:13-14).
 - 3) Submissive to praying in faith (Matt. 21:22).
 - 3. God answers prayers in 2 ways Yes/My grace is sufficient.
