THE NEW TESTAMENT PLAN OF MINISTRY

Acts 6:1-8

I. THE DEACON'S RESPONSIBILITY

- 1. (v. 1) They were elected to solve a problem and to meet needs.
 - A. The widows were being neglected of life's necessities.
 - B. James 1:27 Visitation, ministry, and a pure lifestyle.
 - C. The deacon's job is to meet spiritual and basic needs of people.
- 2. (v. 3) The Biblical type of men the church & God wants needs are men of good report, full of the Holy Spirit, full of God-given wisdom.
- 3. (v. 6) The church prayed and ordained these men with the laying on of their hands of blessing.

II. THE PREACHER'S RESPONSIBILITY

- 1. (v. 2) The preacher's job is to stay in the Word of God.
- 2. (v. 4) The preachers were to give themselves to prayer, study, and the proclamation of God's Word.
- 3. People have gotten all confused about what the preacher's job is.
- 4. It's the church's responsibility is ministering to needy folks, in the church and surrounding community.
- 5. The pastor is to be an example, but he is to equip the church to carry out the work of ministry as stated in Ephesians 4:11-16.
- 6. Balanced church growth implements the NT ministry by pastors equipping the saints and, as they minister together, God blesses.
- 7. To build a lighthouse for God, you must abide by the NT pattern.

III. THE RESULT WHEN THE DEACONS, LAITY, AND PREACHER DO OUR BIBLICAL JOBS

- 1. (v. 7a) The proclamation of God's word kept increasing.
- 2. (v. 7b) The number of disciples kept on increasing.
- 3. (v. 7c) Many priests were even becoming obedient to the faith.
- 4. (v. 8) The spirit-filled deacon made a great impression for God.

Conclusion:

Look what God does when the laity and preachers work together to follow God's pattern for His church.
