2022 Season of Prayer for State Missions and the Janie Chapman Offering September 11-18 State Goal: \$2,100,000

Janie Chapman Offering for State Missions, Missions Education, and Kingdom ADVANCE in South Carolina.

WHO WAS JANIE CHAPMAN?

In 1902, Janie Weston Chapman was elected the first president of South Carolina Woman's Missionary Union, Auxiliary to South Carolina Baptist Convention SM. She was the wife of a prominent upstate pastor, J.D. Chapman. In 1937, WMU's state missions offering was named "The Mrs. J. D. Chapman Offering for State Interests" to honor Mrs. Chapman's strong missions leadership. In 1985, the name was changed to the "Janie Chapman Offering." The permanent logo for South Carolina Woman's Missionary Union's Janie Chapman Offering for State Missions, Missions Education, and Kingdom ADVANCE in South Carolina appropriately combines the symbols of WMU and South Carolina.
